Summary:


On June 5th at approximately 9:10 AM Colton Police Officers were dispatched to the 1400 block of East Santo Antonio Drive in the City of Colton in reference to a hysterical female saying her mother had just stabbed her and her children. Colton Police Officers immediately responded to the apartment and found three female victims one of them was already deceased. The two living victims were transported to a local hospital with multiple stab wounds to their body. The suspect is the maternal grandmother to the victim children and mother to the female adult victim. The suspect Darrington-Clark was gone from the location upon police arrival and is actively being sought by the Colton Police Department for homicide. The vehicle Darrington-Clark is believed to be driving is a black 2013 4 door Hyundai Sonata bearing California License plate (7TQL009), she is described as an African-American female 43 years old 5'-09" 210 pounds with short black hair and brown eyes. The Colton Police Department Detective Division is investigating this homicide and the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Crime Scene Investigation is assisting with evidence collection at the crime scene. If anyone has any information regarding the whereabouts of the suspect Nicole Darrington-Clark they are encouraged to contact the Colton Police Department at 909 370-5000. If you see the suspect or her vehicle please do not make any contact as she is considered armed and dangerous rather call 911 and report her location.

*****UPDATE*****

On June 6th 2017 at about 4:15am the suspect Nicole Darrington was taken into custody in the area of 9th Street and Waterman Avenue in the City of San Bernardino. A San Bernardino County Sheriff's Deputy who was patrolling the area and spotted the vehicle behind a closed business, called for

back-up, and contacted the occupant of the vehicle which was the suspect Nicole Darrington, and the vehicle is being held as evidence pending a search warrant. Nicole Darrington was booked into the San Bernardino County jail on murder charges with bail set at one million dollars. The two surviving victims are listed in stable condition at a local area hospital. Her booking photo is below:
