Twenty-One Contacted And Two Arrested During Bicycle & Pedestrian Safety Operation

Colton, Calif. – On May 6, 2025, the Colton Police Department held a bicycle and pedestrian safety operation from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Officers focused their enforcement efforts on main thoroughfares throughout the city. During the operation, a total of 21 individuals were contacted. Three individuals received citations for various traffic-related offenses, and two were apprehended for outstanding arrest warrants.

Chief A. Vega stated, “Safety is a collective responsibility, and drivers play a crucial role in ensuring the well-being of all road users. We hope this operation serves as a valuable reminder to everyone to exercise caution and look out for one another.”
