FATAL TRAFFIC COLLISION

COLTON, CA — On July 9, 2025, at approximately 12:00 PM, Colton Police Officers responded to a report of a traffic collision near the intersection of North Mt. Vernon Avenue and East "C" Street in the City of Colton. Upon arrival, officers located a Toyota Prius, operating as a rideshare vehicle, which had been involved in a traffic collision with a Yamaha motorcycle occupied by a single rider.

Emergency personnel attempted life-saving measures on the motorcyclist; however, he succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene. The passenger of the Toyota Prius received medical aid at the scene and was transported to Arrowhead Regional Medical Center, where he later died from his injuries. The driver of the Prius did not appear to be injured, declined medical attention, and fully cooperated with investigators.

The identities of the deceased individuals are currently pending official identification by the San Bernardino County Coroner's office.

The Colton Police Department, Major Accident Investigation Team (MAIT) responded to the scene and is conducting the investigation.
