38 Drivers Cited At DUI Checkpoint



Colton, Calif. — On August 29, 2025 the Colton Police Department conducted a DUI and Driver's License checkpoint in the 1700 block of S. La Cadena Dr, from 6:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m. A total of 1029 vehicles passed through the checkpoint, with 483 screened for signs of intoxication or driving without a license. 16 individuals were cited for driving without a license. 4 individuals were cited for driving on a suspended license. Additionally, 18 drivers received citations for various traffic-related offenses.

DUI checkpoint locations are selected based on reported incidents of impaired driving-related crashes. The primary objective of these checkpoints is to enhance public safety by removing suspected impaired drivers from the roads.

Further DUI checkpoints will be conducted in the future at undisclosed locations. This checkpoint was funded by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
