### Fatal Traffic Collision

**COLTON, CA.** — On February 6, 2026, at approximately 4:00 a.m., Colton Police Officers responded to a report of a traffic collision at the intersection of Riverside Avenue and Key Street in the City of Colton, San Bernardino County. Upon arrival, officers discovered a bicyclist had been struck by an unknown vehicle that fled the scene. A male subject succumbed to his injuries on scene. The victim was later identified as Sinahi Moises Garcia of Corona, CA.

The Colton Police Department's Major Accident Investigation Team (MAIT) responded and assumed the investigation. The cause of the collision is currently under investigation.
