DUI Checkpoint Nets Four Arrests, Sixteen Citations and Two Tows.

Colton, Calif. – Colton Police Department had (1) felon in possession of a loaded firearm, (1) DUI arrest and (2) criminal warrant arrests while conducting a DUI/Driver's License checkpoint on November 26, 2021. The checkpoint was conducted in the 1700 block of S. La Cadena Drive for southbound traffic between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m.

In addition, fifteen (15) drivers were cited for operating a vehicle unlicensed or with a suspended/revoked license, (1) citation for failing to obey traffic control device and two (2) vehicles towed. DUI Checkpoints are placed in locations based on collision statistics and frequency of DUI arrests.

Drivers caught driving impaired and charged with DUI can expect the impact of a DUI arrest to be approximately \$13,500. This includes fines, fees, DUI classes, license suspension and other expenses not to mention possible jail time.

Colton Police Department reminds drivers that "DUI Doesn't Just Mean Booze." Prescription drugs, particularly those with a driving or operating machinery warning on the label, can impair and result in a DUI. Marijuana can also be impairing, especially in combination with alcohol or other drugs.
